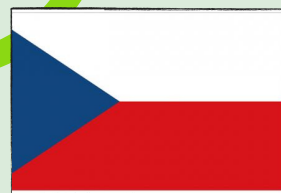

Budapest (Hungary) – Murska Sobota 290 km

Trieste (Italy) – Murska Sobota – 301 km

We recommend traveling to Vienna, Budapest, or Zagreb, and then taking a Flixbus to Maribor, from where we can arrange transportation to accommodation.

Accommodation, food and materials are covered by the program. Please plan your travel to Slovenia from the place of your permanent residence to the accomodation according to the travel limit shown in the table below. Your travel costs will be reimbursed up to the limit, if you spend less you will get what you spent.

Reimbursements of travel costs can only be done upon full attendance of the youth exchange. Choose the most economical/cheap way of transportation (2nd class trains, bus. Using a plane is not recommended for distances shorter than 1000 km). Only public transportation can be reimbursed (no taxis). Save all travel tickets in original, boarding pass and invoices for reimbursement.
