## DESCRIPTION

In a world thoroughly affected by rapidly and dangerously changing climate, caused by extensive human activities, more and more we more desperately yearn for solutions that will help us survive. - Present national insights on the issue of forest and nature protection.
- Illustrate multiple ways how the deforestation can be countered.
- Suggest creative methods how to promote nature protection and sustainability.

## FLIGHT OPTIONS

You can search for the flights to Bratislava, Vienna , Budapest or Prague.

If you arrive to **Bratislava**, you can check connections to Trnava on [www.cp.sk](http://www.cp.sk).  
(bus/train, 30 - 60minutes, price around 5 eur).

If you arrive to **Vienna** Schwechat airport, you will take a direct bus to Bratislava (duration 1 hour, price 5 eur, companies Regiojet, Slovaklines or Flixbus) and then from Bratislava to Trnava again you can check connections on [www.cp.sk](http://www.cp.sk).

If you arrive to **Budapest** airport, you will take public transport in the city and then either a bus or a train to Bratislava (3 hours, price 15 - 20 eur). From Bratislava to Trnava you can check connections on [www.cp.sk](http://www.cp.sk).

If you arrive to **Prague** airport, you will take public transport in the city and then either a bus or a train to Bratislava (5 hours, price 20 eur +). From Bratislava to Trnava you can check connections on [www.cp.sk](http://www.cp.sk).

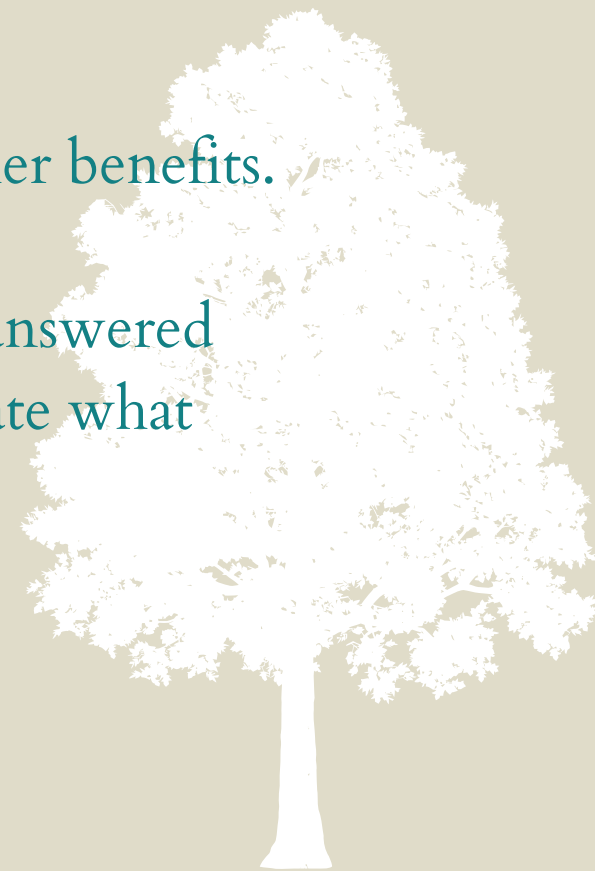
# YOUTHPASS
